## Northborough Community Gardens Guidelines and Rules

- I will pay a fee of \$30 to help cover garden expenses.
- I will have my garden planted by April 15<sup>th</sup> and keep it planted all summer long.
- If I must abandon my plot for any reason, I will notify the Recreation Dept.
- I will keep weeds at a minimum and maintain the areas immediately surrounding my plot.
- If my plot becomes unkempt, I understand I will be given one week's notice to clean it up. After that time, it will be re-assigned or tilled in if necessary.
- I will keep trash and litter out of the plot, as well as from adjacent pathways and fences.
- I will participate in the fall cleanup of the garden.
- I will plant tall crops only where they will not shade neighboring plots.
- I will pick only my own crops unless given permission by another plot user.
- I will not use fertilizers, insecticides or weed repellents that will in any way affect other plots.
- I will not bring pets to the garden.
- I understand that neither the garden group nor owners of the land are responsible for my actions.
- I THEREFORE AGREE TO HOLD HARMLESS THE GARDEN GROUP AND OWNERS OF THE LAND FOR ANY LIABILITY, DAMAGE, LOSS OR CLAIM THAT OCCURS IN CONNECTION WITH USE OF THE GARDEN BY ME OR ANY OF MY GUESTS.
